QUORUM COURT MEETING JULY 17, 2023

The Cross County Quorum Court held a regular meeting Monday, July 17, 2023, in the lobby of the Cross County Courthouse at 6:00 p.m. Judge Lynn Blake called the meeting to order. Prayer was said by Justice Kevin Jumper, and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited. The roll was called, and all Justices were present except Justice Glenda Vance. Justice Carl Loewer made a motion to approve the minutes from the June 2023 regular meeting with Justice Gloria Aldridge seconding the motion. A voice vote was taken, and all Justices present were in favor.

Budget Reports: Justice Scott May reported that the budget committee will be scheduling a meeting soon to start working on the budget.

Personnel Report: Justice Glenda Vance was absent and no one else on the committee had anything to report.

Building Report: Justice Carl Loewer reported there are leaks in several buildings that he is aware of and working on.

Road/Bridges Report: Justice Jerry Rushing reported that the road department is doing regular grading and they are working on finishing CR 7011 since FEMA is paying 75% of that repair due to the tornado damage.

Sheriff Report: Sheriff David West gave the sheriff report.

A motion was made by Justice Jerry Rushing with Justice Carl Loewer seconding it. A voice vote was taken and all Justices present were in favor.

An Ordinance to be entitled: AN EMERGENY ORDINANCE ADOPTING CERTAIN RULES AND REGULATIONS CONCERNING EXTERNAL NOISE ATTENUATION OF DATA CENTERS AND TO PREVENT NOISE DISTURBANCE IN CROSS COUNTY AND WITHIN ITS UNINCORPORATED LIMITS; TO DECALRE AN EMERGENGY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES; The ordinance was sponsored by Justice Carl Loewer. The ordinance was read by County Attorney Vince Guest. Justice Carl Loewer made a motion to accept the ordinance with Justice Jerry Rushing seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken, and all Justices voted in favor. Ordinance 2023-18 has been duly adopted and recorded in the Quorum Court book of Records.

Public comments were made and Sheriff David West asked the Quorum Court for their advice on purchasing Deputy vehicles.

A motion to adjourn was made by Justice Jerry Rushing and seconded by Justice Carl Loewer. A voice vote was taken, and all Justices present voted in favor. The meeting was adjourned.
