An objection must be filed in writing with the County Clerk if an official is a spouse of a county election commissioner, a county party chair, or spouse of a county party chair within 7 days of February 12. An objection that an official is a candidate's spouse or related by blood within two degrees must be filed within 10 days of February 12.
