The Cross County Quorum Court held a meeting January 14, 2019 in the lobby of the Cross County Courthouse at 6:00 p.m. Judge Donnie Sanders called the meeting to order. Prayer was said by Justice Jerry Brewster and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited. The roll was called and all Justices were present except Justice Kent Goff. Judge Donnie Sanders read a letter from Justice Kent Goff resigning from District 2. Justice Carl Loewer made a motion to approve the minutes for December 2018 with Justice Gary Eakin seconding the motion. A voice vote was taken and all Justices present were in favor.


A motion was made by Justice Carl Loewer with Justice Doug Kennon seconding it for a vote on a 7/8% (.875%) construction bond sales and use tax with a sunset. A 1/8%

(.125%) maintenance and operation sales and use tax with a sunset. A voice vote was taken with two (2) Justices voting yes and six (6) Justices voting no.

A motion was made by Justice Gloria Aldridge with Justice Carl Loewer seconding it for a vote on a 7/8% (.875%) construction bond sales and use tax with a sunset. A 1/8% (.125%) maintenance and operation sales and use tax without a sunset. A voice vote was taken with six (6) Justices voting yes and two (2) Justices voting no.

A motion to adjourn was made by Justice Lynn Blake and seconded by Justice Carl Loewer. A voice vote was taken and all Justices were in favor. Meeting was adjourned.
