QUORUM COURT MEETING MARCH 18, 2019

The Cross County Quorum Court held a regular meeting March 18, 2019 in the lobby of the Cross County Courthouse at 6:00 p.m. Judge Donnie Sanders called the meeting to order. Prayer was said by Justice Jerry Brewster and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited. The roll was called and all Justices were present except for Justice Glenda Vance. Justice Carl Loewer made a motion to approve the minutes for February 2019 with Justice Doug Kennon seconding the motion. A voice vote was taken and all Justices present were in favor.

Budget/ Personnel Report: No Report

Building Committee Report: Justice Doug Kennon reported Cross County will have a Jail Tax election on April 9, 2019.

Road/Bridges Committee Report: No Report

Personnel Committee Report: Justice Gary Eakin reported the personnel committee has finalized the 2019 starting salary list. They will write an ordinance and take it in front of the Quorum Court for approval.

An Ordinance to be entitled: AN AMENDMENT TO THE 2019 BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE \$25,000.00 FROM UNAPPROPRIATED ROAD FUNDS TO ROAD FUND LINE ITEM #2000-2004005 VEHICLES. The Ordinance was read by Justice Doug Kennon. A motion was made by Justice Lynn Blake with Justice Gary Eakin seconding it. The roll was called and all Justices present voted yes. Ordinance #2019-5 has been duly adopted and recorded in the Quorum Court Book of Records.

An Ordinance to be entitled: AN AMENDMENT TO THE 2019 BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE \$9,350.18 FROM UNAPPROPRIATED TREASURER'S AUTOMATION FUND TO TREASURER'S AUTOMATION FUND LINE ITEM #3000-01032024 SERVICE CONTRACTS. The Ordinance was read by Justice Lynn Blake. A motion was made by Justice Doug Kennon with Justice Carl Loewer seconding it. The roll was called and all Justices

present voted yes. Ordinance #2019-6 has been duly adopted and recorded in the Quorum Court Book of Records.

An Ordinance to be entitled: AN AMENDMENT TO AUTHORIZE THE CROSS COUNTY TO PURCHASE SERVICES OF CROSS COUNTY IRRIGATION & POWER AS PROVIDED BY ARKANSAS ANNOTATED CODE §14-14-1202. The Ordinance was read by Justice Gary Eakin. A motion was made by Justice Lynn Blake with Justice Jerry Brewster seconding it. The roll was called and all Justices voted yes, except Justice Scott May who abstained and Justice Glenda Vance who was absent. Ordinance #2019-7 has been duly adopted and recorded in the Quorum Court Book of Records.

An Ordinance to be entitled: AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT VICIOUS DOGS IN THE COUNTY FROM RUNNING ASTRAY. The Ordinance was read by Justice Lynn Blake. A motion was made by Justice Jerry Brewster with Justice Scott May seconding it. The roll was called and all Justices present voted yes. Ordinance #2019-8 has been duly adopted and recorded in the Quorum Court Book of Records.

A Resolution to be entitled: A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING EXECUTION OF AN EQUIPMENT LEASE-PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH BANCORPSOUTH EQUIPMENT FINANCE, A DIVISION OF BANCORPSOUTH BANK FOR THE PURPOSE OF LEASE-PURCHASING CERTAIN EQUIPMENT. The Resolution was read by Justice Carl Loewer. A motion was made by Justice Lynn Blake with Justice Doug Kennon seconding it. The roll was called and all Justices present voted yes. Resolution #2019-4 has been duly adopted and recorded in the Quorum Court Book of Records.

An Ordinance to be entitled: AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE OFFENSE AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF NEGLIGENT OPERATION OF A MOTOR VEHICLE IN CROSS COUNTY. The Ordinance was read by Justice Lynn Blake. A motion was made by Justice Lynn Blake with Justice Gloria Aldridge seconding it. The roll was called and all Justices present voted yes. Ordinance #2019-9 has been duly adopted and recorded in the Quorum Court Book of Records.

An Ordinance to be entitled: AN AMENDMENT TO THE 2019 BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE \$3,000.00 FROM UNAPPROPRIATED ASSESSOR'S AMENDMENT 79 FUND TO ASSESSOR'S AMENDMENT 79 FUND LINE ITEM #3004-1052002. The Ordinance was read by Justice Lynn Blake. A motion was made by Justice Doug Kennon with Justice Gary Eakin seconding it. The roll was called and all Justices voted yes except Justice Glenda Vance and Justice Gloria Aldridge who were absent. Ordinance #2019-10 has been duly adopted and recorded in the Quorum Court Book of Records.

A motion to adjourn was made by Justice Lynn Blake and seconded by Justice Gary Eakin. A voice vote was taken and all Justices present were in favor. Meeting was adjourned.
