QUORUM COURT MEETING MAY 20, 2019

The Cross County Quorum Court held a regular meeting May 20, 2019 in the lobby of the Cross County Courthouse at 6:00 p.m. Judge Donnie Sanders called the meeting to order. Prayer was said by Justice Jerry Brewster and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited. The roll was called and all Justices were present. Justice Carl Loewer made a motion to approve the minutes for April 2019 with Justice Jerry Brewster seconding the motion. A voice vote was taken and all Justices were in favor.

Budget Report: No Report

Building Committee Report: No Report

Road/Bridges Committee Report: Justice Jerry Brewster reported that the Road Department will start paving Cathy's Lake Road in the next month and they met with The State Aid Committee.

Personnel Committee Report: Justice Gary Eakin reported the committee has been going over personnel issues and salaries.

A Resolution to be entitled: A RESOLUTION RESTRUCTURING OF THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE. The Resolution was read by Justice Lynn Blake. A motion was made by Justice Lynn Blake with Justice Scott May seconding it. The roll was called and four (4) Justices voted yes and five (5) Justices votes no. The Resolution Restructuring of the Sheriff's office did not pass.

An Ordinance to be entitled: AN ORDINANCE FOR PROMOTIONS IN THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE DUE TO RESTRUCTURING THE DEPARTMENT. THE 2019 BUDGET WILL NOT BE AMENDED SINCE APPROPRIATIONS ARE NOT NECESSARY. THE RAISES ARE RETROACTIVE TO FEBRUARY 1, 2019. The Ordinance was read by Justice Gary Eakin. A motion was made by Justice Lynn Blake with Justice Glenda Vance seconding it. The roll was called and all Justices voted yes. Ordinance #2019-16 has been duly adopted and recorded in the Quorum Court Book of Records.

An Ordinance to be entitled: AN ORDINANCE TO RAISE STARTING SALARIES FOR JAILERS IN THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE. THE 2019 BUDGET WILL NOT BE AMENDED SINCE APPROPRIATIONS ARE NOT NECESSARY. THE RAISES ARE RETROACTIVE TO JANUARY 1, 2019. The Ordinance was read by Justice Jerry Brewster. A motion was made by Justice Scott May with Justice Lynn Blake seconding it. The roll was called and all Justices voted yes. Ordinance #2019-17 has been duly adopted and recorded in the Quorum Court Book of Records.

A Resolution to be entitled: A RESOLUTION APPOINTING MICHAEL LADD, JERRY ROBERTS AND KEVIN WATTS TO THE CROSS COUNTY LAW LIBRARY BOARD. The Resolution was read by Justice Carl Loewer. A motion was made by Justice Lynn Blake with Justice Doug Kennon seconding it. The roll was called and all Justices voted yes. Resolution #2019-5 has been duly adopted and recorded in the Quorum Court Book of Records.

An Ordinance to be entitled: AN AMENDMENT TO THE 2019 BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE \$2,500.00 FROM UNAPPROPRIATED BOAT SAFETY FUND TO BOAT SAFETY SPECIAL PROJECTS FUND LINE ITEM #3019-4003093. The Ordinance was read by Justice Rick Palmer. A motion was made by Justice Glenda Vance with Justice Scott May seconding it. The roll was called and all Justices voted yes. Ordinance #2019-18 has been duly adopted and recorded in the Quorum Court Book of Records.

An Ordinance to be entitled: AN AMENDMENT TO THE 2019 BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE \$175,000.00 FROM UNAPPROPRIATED COUNTY GENERAL FUND TO COUNTY BUILDINGS SPECIAL PROJECTS FUND LINE ITEM #1000-1113154. The Ordinance was read by Justice Lynn Blake. A motion was made by Justice Doug Kennon with Justice Jerry Brewster seconding it. The roll was called and all Justices voted yes. Ordinance #2019-19 has been duly adopted and recorded in the Quorum Court Book of Records.

An Ordinance to be entitled: AN ORDINANCE TO PAY OVERTIME TO DEPUTIES WITH THE AWARDED GRANT UNDER THE MINI SELECTIVE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM. The Ordinance was read by Justice Glenda Vance. A motion was made by Justice Scott May with Justice Lynn Blake seconding it. The roll was called and all Justices voted yes. Ordinance #2019-20 has been duly adopted and recorded in the Quorum Court Book of Records.



The Ordinance was read by Justice Doug Kennon. A motion was made by Justice Lynn Blake to suspend the rules and put

the ordinance on second reading, title only with Justice Glenda Vance seconding it. The roll was called and all Justices voted yes. Justice Doug Kennon read the ordinance by title only for the second reading. A motion was made by Justice Gary Eakin to suspend the rules and put the ordinance on third

Reading, title only with Justice Glenda Vance seconding it. The roll was called and all Justices voted yes. Justice Doug Kennon read the ordinance by title only for the third reading. Justice Lynn Blake made a motion to invoke the emergency clause and it was seconded by Justice Gloria Aldridge. The roll was called and all Justices voted yes. Ordinance #2019-21 has been duly adopted and recorded in the Quorum Court Book of Records.

A motion to adjourn was made by Justice Gary Eakin and seconded by Justice Glenda Vance. A voice vote was taken and all Justices were in favor. Meeting was adjourned.
