Adoption of a 1% local sales and use tax within Cross County for a period of 48 months, the net collections of which remaining after the deduction of the administrative charges of the State of Arkansas and required rebates shall be distributed to and used by the County to assist in operating and maintaining hospital and related health care and support facilities, including particularly, without limitation, the hospital facility known as CrossRidge Community Hospital which is owned by the County and currently leased to St. Bernards Community Hospital Corporation d/b/a/ CrossRidge Community Hospital. Municipalities in the County will not receive a share of the tax collections. The levy of the sales and use tax shall commence on October 1, 2020 and expire on September 30, 2024.
