

CROSS COUNTY QUORUM COURT
ORDINANCE NO. 2010-47

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY OF CROSS TO PURCHASE THE SERVICE OF DEPUTY GLEN SOUTH OF THE CROSS COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE, AS PROVIDED BY ARKANSAS CODE 14-14-1202.

WHEREAS, Ark. Code 14-14-1202 (c) (2) (A) explicitly authorizes the Quorum Court to act in the best interest of the County and to permit the County to allow purchases directly or indirectly from County officials due to unusual circumstances.

WHEREAS, The Cross County has had a maintenance agreement with Glenn South to maintain the radio towers and equipment prior to becoming a paid employee of Cross County. Deputy Glen South of the Cross County Sheriff's Office is a trained technician in two way radio repair and installation and trouble shooting with over 30 years experience.

WHEREAS, due to the past working relationship, prompt service, and technical knowledge of the radio equipment of the Cross County Sheriff's Office it would be in the best interest to continue to do business with Glen South.

THEREFORE, the Quorum Court of Cross County declares that unusual circumstances exist as provided for under Ark. Code 14-14-1202 (c) (2) (A) and that it is in the best interest of Cross County to allow Glen South to continue to sell, service and maintain all emergency and two way radio equipment for the Sheriff's Office, Road Department, and Office of Emergency Services.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF CROSS COUNTY, ARKANSAS.
