QUORUM COURT MEETING FEBRUARY 22, 2021

The Cross County Quorum Court held a regular meeting February 22, 2021 in the Court Room of the Cross County Courthouse at 6:00 p.m. Judge Donnie Sanders called the meeting to order. Prayer was said and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited. The roll was called and all Justices were present. Justice Lynn Blake made a motion to approve the January, 2021 minutes with Justice Glenda Vance seconding the motion. A voice vote was taken and all Justices were in favor.

Budget Reports: Judge Donnie Sanders gave an update on the budget and will meet with the County Elected Officials to discuss it.

Building Report: Judge Donnie Sanders gave an update on the construction of the Cross County Jail.

Road/Bridges Report: Judge Donnie Sanders reported he is working on the right of way easements on CR 372. The middle section of the road should be paved and completed this year.

Personnel Report: No Report


An Ordinance to be entitled: AN AMENDMENT TO THE 2021 BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE \$19,000.00 FROM UNAPPROPRIATED COUNTY GENERAL FUND TO COURTHOUSE MAINTENANCE FUND LINE ITEM #100-1082023. The Ordinance was read by Justice Lynn Blake. A motion was made by Justice Carl Loewer with Justice Glenda Vance seconding it. The roll was called and all Justices voted yes. Ordinance #2021-2 has been duly adopted and recorded in the Quorum Court Book of Records.

An Ordinance to be entitled: AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO ADDRESS LEAVE POLICIES IN TIMES OF A PUBLIC-HEALTH EMERGENCY DECLARED BY THE GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS. The Ordinance was read by Justice Glenda Vance. A motion was made by Justice Lynn Blake with an addition that an employee does not exceed their normal hours for any fourteen (14) day period with Justice Jerry Rushing seconding it. The roll was called and all Justices voted yes. Ordinance #2021-3 has been duly adopted and recorded in the Quorum Court Book of Records.

Judge Donnie Sanders discussed the personnel Handbook Committee Appointments.

A motion to adjourn was made by Justice Carl Loewer and seconded by Justice Gloria Aldridge. A voice vote was taken and all Justices were in favor. Meeting was adjourned.
