

Full bid specification information can be obtained by contacting Mike Hamrick.

All bids should meet or exceed specifications requested.

Please, submit bids on the form enclosed.

The bid must be signed with the firm name and by an authorized employee of the company.

Any bids received after bid starting time will not be accepted.

No changes or additions will be accepted after submitting the bid.

Cross County reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids.

All prices quoted will remain firm for 30 days from the date of the bid opening.

Bidder must indicate whether they meet the bid specifications requested by marking yes or no on the Bid Specification Form. If the specifications do not meet or exceed specifications requested please indicate what is being offered on a separate page.

Include product literature, full specifications, and warranty in bid package. If extended warranties are available list the offerings and pricing on a separate sheet.

All equipment must be delivered by the time the current lease expires in December.

All pricing should be calculated to include delivery to the Cross County shop.

All bidders must offer a "Guaranteed Repurchase Agreement" for 2 and 3 years from the date of delivery of the new trucks. The bidder must also offer monthly payments, in arrears, for the two and three year term the trucks are in service. The Cross County reserves the right to turn in the trucks at the end of the two or three year term or payoff the note and keep the trucks. Any terms and conditions associated with the "Guaranteed Repurchase Agreement" should be included in the bids.

The unit proposed shall include all necessary equipment and be completed and ready for use. All parts not specifically mentioned, but which are required for a complete unit shall be furnished according to current standard design of the manufacturer. Bidders must be authorized sales, parts, and service facility for the make it represents body and chassis. Bidders must be able to perform warranty work on all truck components. Bidder must carry an adequate inventory of parts necessary for making repairs. The parts & service facility must be located within 85 miles from the Cross County shop. Hours of operation may be a deciding factor of which trucks to lease.
