QUORUM COURT MEETING MAY 17, 2021

The Cross County Quorum Court held a regular meeting May 17, 2021 in the Court Room of the Cross County Courthouse at 6:00 p.m. Judge Donnie Sanders called the meeting to order. Prayer was said by Justice Kevin Jumper and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited. The roll was called and all Justices were present. Justice Carl Loewer made a motion to approve the minutes from the April 2021 regular meeting with Justice Lynn Blake seconding the motion. A voice vote was taken and all Justices were in favor.

Building Report: Justice Kevin Jumper reported The County Detention Facility construction is ahead of schedule.

Resolution #2021-5 has been duly adopted and recorded in the Quorum Court Book of Records.

An Ordinance to be entitled: AN AMENDMENT TO THE 2021 BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE \$84,086.49 FROM UNAPPROPRIATED COUNTY GENERAL FUND TO COUNTY JAIL FUND FOR TWO (2) ADDITIONAL JAILERS FOR THE CROSS COUNTY DETENTION CENTER AND \$32,086.69 FROM UNAPPROPRIATED GENERAL FUNDS TO COUNTY SHERIFF FUND FOR ONE (1) NEWLY CREATED RECEPTIONIST POSITION AT THE NEW CROSS COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE AND DETENTION CENTER. The Ordinance was read by Justice Scott May. A motion was made by Justice Lynn Blake with Justice Kyle Wilson seconding it. A motion was made by Justice Lynn Blake to suspend the rules and put the ordinance on title only third reading with Justice Glenda Vance seconding it. The roll was called and all Justices voted yes. The ordinance title was read three times. A motion was made by Justice Lynn Blake and Justice Amy Imboden seconding it. The roll was called and all Justices voted yes. Ordinance #2021-10 has been duly adopted and recorded in the Quorum Court Book of Records.

A motion to adjourn was made by Justice Lynn Blake and seconded by Justice Jerry Rushing. A voice vote was taken and all Justices were in favor. Meeting was adjourned.
