QUORUM COURT MEETING FEBRUARY 28, 2022

The Cross County Quorum Court held a regular meeting February 28, 2022 in the Lobby of the Cross County Courthouse at 6:00 p.m. Judge Donnie Sanders called the meeting to order. Prayer was said by Justice Glenda Vance and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited. The roll was called and all Justices were present except Justice Gloria Aldridge. Justice Lynn Blake made a motion to approve the minutes from the January 2022 regular meeting with Justice Glenda Vance seconding the motion. A voice vote was taken and all Justices present were in favor.

Budget Reports: Justice Lynne Blake reported due to weather conditions they had not been able to meet but one will be scheduled.

Personnel Report: Justice Carl Loewer stated that they will discuss their report later in the meeting.

Building Report: No Report

Road/Bridges Report: Justice Scott May reported that the road department has been working diligently on the county roads due to the weather.

Sheriff Report: Sheriff David West handed out his report.

Representative Aaron Chin, Project Developer with Vestas/ American Wind Technology Inc., and Counsel Mark Brady discussed the possibility of a Wind Turbine Farm in Cross County.

The court approved the Financial and Compliance report from the Auditors with a voice vote.

An Ordinance to be entitled: AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE PROCEDURES FOR SPECIAL MEETINGS OF THE QUORUM COURT. The Ordinance was read by Justice Lynn Blake. A motion to accept was made by Justice Carl Loewer with Justice Glenda Vance seconding it. The roll was called with all Justices present voting yes. Ordinance No. 2022-3 has been duly adopted and recorded in the Quorum Court Book of Records.

An Ordinance to be entitled: AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED STARTING SALARIES OF ALL COUNTY ELECTED OFFICIALS 2022. The Ordinance was read by Justice Scott May. A motion to accept was made by Justice Lynn Blake with Justice Carl Loewer seconding it. The roll was called with all Justices present voting yes. Ordinance No. 2022-4 has been duly adopted and recorded in the Quorum Court Book of Records.

An Ordinance to be entitled: A RESOLUTION DECLARING A VACANCY IN THE OFFICE OF CROSS COUNTY TREASURER. The Resolution was read by Justice Carl Loewer. A motion to accept

was made by Justice Lynn Blake with Justice Glenda Vance seconding it. The roll was called with all Justices present voting yes. Resolution No. 2022-1 has been duly adopted and recorded in the Quorum Court Book of Records.

A motion was made by Justice Lynn Blake and seconded by Justice Carl Loewer to return all sick time, vacation time, and previous salary back to Tammy Crouch once her appointment is fulfilled and she returns to an employee position.

No public comments were made.

A motion to adjourn was made by Justice Kevin Jumper and seconded by Justice Lynn Blake. A voice vote was taken and all Justices present were in favor. Meeting was adjourned.
