QUORUM COURT SPECIAL MEETING AUGUST 29, 2022

The Cross County Quorum Court held a special meeting August 29, 2022, in the Lobby of the Cross County Courthouse at 6:00 p.m. Judge Donnie Sanders called the meeting to order and said the prayer. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. The roll was called, and all Justices were present except Justice Amy Imboden, Justice Glenda Vance, Justice Gloria Aldridge and Justice Kevin Jumper.

County Judge Donnie Sanders explained that the meeting was called because the bank has requested Quorum Court approval for the loan to get graders. A motion was made by Justice Lynn Blake and seconded by Justice Carl Loewer to move forward with the grader loan. A voice vote was taken, and all Justices present voted yes.

The next item of business was an open discussion on the solar farm and whether the Quorum Court wants to accept the offer on the table now which is 65% abatement and 30 years or come up with a counteroffer.
